- Select your tree and bring it home. We have many different varieties of trees that look excellent as Christmas trees! There are also different sizes.
- ❖ Slowly transition your tree from the outdoors to inside. Start by placing your tree in locations such as a garage or porch to get it used to a warmer environment. This process should take about a week. Why? The large temperature difference may result in new growth on your tree, which you will want to avoid at this time.
- ❖ Once indoors place in a cool location, preferably with lots of natural lighting! Your tree should remain indoors no longer than 7-10 days.
- ❖ Water! Make sure the root ball of your tree stays evenly moist, without drowning it. Don't forget to place a watering tray under the pot! Water until you see a small amount start to come out of the drain holes of the container. Repeat as necessary.
- Decorate—Carefully! Remember your tree is flammable! So be safe and have fun!
- ❖ Slowly transition back outside. This transition should take about a week. Once the tree is accumulated to the outdoors it can be planted.
